


THE WELL-BEING OF Community



We continue to address the evolving needs of those we serve, strengthening our community along the way. Each of our accomplishments helps us to realize our mission and brings us

MUHLENBERG APARTMENT BUILDING RENOVATION

Our commitment to renewal and renovation took many forms in 2016, most tangibly, the completion of the transformational project at the Muhlenberg Apartment Building at Luther Acres. Everything about the new space is designed to not only enhance life for current residents, but to meet the changing expectations of the next generation of seniors as well. We created an exciting, contemporary new look and feel that has set the standard for how senior living will look in the future.







EXCEEDED OCCUPANCY GOALS

One of the direct results of our commitment to offering a vibrant lifestyle in updated and welcoming spaces has been strong organizational occupancy – the key to financial viability in this ever-changing market. Our overall agency occupancy exceeded budget targets in 2016 by more than 0.7% with Independent Living surpassing budget by 2%. These results speak to the experience we offer for all levels of care at each of our campuses and reflect the commitment our team demonstrates to our core values.



EMPLOYEE ENGAGEMENT SURVEY

Employee engagement has become a top business priority for many organizations – including Luthercare. In our industry, a high-performing workforce is essential for growth and survival. We believe a highly engaged workforce will produce better work, better culture and will ultimately provide better service and care to those we serve. In 2016, we conducted an Employee Engagement Survey that provided us with a wealth of valuable information that will help us make changes that positively impact organizational performance.



Philanthropic support through the giving of both financial resources and time is a critical part of what we do, and 2016 was another successful year. Generous lifetime donors remembered us in their final plans with estate and planned gifts, our appeals were met with strong response and our Luthercare for Kids Golf Tournament generated significant support to provide scholarships for the children and families we serve through our Early Learning Programs. Our Benevolent Care fund assisted residents whose resources became depleted through no fault of their own, allowing them to remain in the communities they've called home for many years. We also raised funds which allowed us to advance nursing careers through scholarships.



SPANG CREST RECEIVES 5-STAR RATING

Quality of care is a core priority, and we are pleased our healthcare centers continue to be among the highest rated in the state. Luther Acres in Lititz received a four-star rating and Spang Crest in Lebanon received a five-star rating – the highest - from the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services.



SAIL GRANTS

Luthercare was awarded a \$40,000 grant from the Lancaster Lancaster County. SAIL provides needed tools and training, using a mobile delivery system, to home-based child care providers in Lancaster County.



YOUR NEIGHBORHOOD **CONNECTION EXPANDS**

Your Neighborhood Connection, our joint venture with Moravian Manor formed in 2014 to provide in-home services, launched in the spring of 2016, serving campus residents from both communities. The organization is staffed to reach beyond the campuses and offer support to individuals in Lititz and surrounding areas during 2017.

HOLLERAN COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT AWARD

Holleran Consulting, a nationally renowned consulting and research firm supporting the senior living industry, named Luthercare one of the recipients of the 2016 Holleran Community Engagement Award. Recipients of the award are recognized as leaders in the field of community engagement, as well as for their organizational vision and commitment to building and strengthening their local communities.



DEBT RESTRUCTURE

In 2016, we restructured Luthercare's debt for two important reasons: 1) flexibility, and 2) cost savings. Flexibility in our debt structure allows us to more easily move forward with any programmatic or campus expansions. And cost savings allow us to continue to more efficiently sustain and support our current programs and campuses and be positioned to consider new opportunities, meeting the strategic vision of the Executive Team moving forward.

HEALTHCARE PARTNERSHIPS

Our healthcare centers were also selected by Lancaster General Health/ Penn Medicine in the Lancaster area and Wellspan Health in the Lebanon area to be members of their Preferred Provider Networks. This participation will strengthen our relationships with these critical community organizations and ultimately create systems to provide even higher quality and more coordinated care to those we serve.

COMPETITIVE ANALYSIS/ PRICING STUDY

We conducted a comprehensive Competitive Analysis mid-year, securing rate and amenity information for a group of senior living communities identified as our strategic competitors those within our geographic area with similar product offerings, amenities and pricing structures. All levels of care were reviewed at all three campuses, with the project yielding valuable information that resulted in many adjustments for 2017.
