One Legacy of Caring

Proves It's Never 2 Late®.

An excited Luther Acres resident eagerly reaches up to touch a computer monitor with her finger. She touches the start button on the 60-inch screen. She's now a DJ leading fellow residents in the healthcare center in an afternoon of karaoke.

Another resident also reaches up to touch the monitor. He likes trivia, so with the push of a button, a heated trivia competition between residents begins.

On a different day, another resident is feeling creative, so she picks up a virtual paintbrush. She dabs it into the paint and begins to work on her next masterpiece.



Whether residents participate in the karaoke, trivia or painting activities that are taking place on any given day, all residents can see what's happening on a projection of the computer screen.

These virtual experiences are courtesy of *It's Never 2 Late*® (iN2L), a customized computer system with therapeutic and entertainment content and hardware for use in senior living communities. It is an integrated program designed to help

residents connect, engage and enjoy life – regardless of their cognitive or physical capabilities.

"It's Never 2 Late combines cognitive activities, interpersonal and group engagement, and technical skill-building to create experiences for residents that are just plain fun," says Mary Schreiber, Therapeutic Recreation Manager at Luther Acres Healthcare Center. "The program can enhance quality of life by allowing them to share their world with their

families, friends and caregivers. So far, they just love it."

Mary adds the staff is equally excited about iN2L and is eager to take advantage of the program's full potential.

"Forward-thinking senior communities know that access to computer technology for residents is not a luxury, it's an expectation," says William Snyder, Luthercare Vice President of Philanthropy and

Community Engagement. "Families are spread out all over the country, and the ability to stay in touch is critically important. With iN2L, residents have their own accounts and families can upload pictures and share stories any time they want."

Another key benefit of iN2L is the positive effect it can have on those living with memory loss. Research shows a vital link between mental stimulation and slowing the progression of Alzheimer's disease. Computer-related activities such as those available through iN2L provide that stimulation.

"iN2L is a great way to interact with those in the more advanced stages of dementia," says Bill. "One of the reasons we like this program so much is that it proves there is never a reason to give up on people who seem unreachable. There are ways to connect with them."

"When I first heard of this program, I knew it was a tool that had the potential to enhance life for residents greatly," says Carla Weidman, whose mother – Mary Jane Fassnacht – was a Luther Acres resident for over a decade. Carla says her mother loved life at Luther Acres and wanted to leave a memorial gift that was useful for residents. "iN2L was the perfect solution," she says.

Carla and Mary Jane had a long-distance relationship for much of Mary Jane's time at Luther Acres. "A platform like iN2L would have been a great way for us to stay connected and it would have been an effective way for her to remain connected to her friends throughout the community," says Carla. "Better yet, it's a tool that encourages group socialization, and all residents benefit from that. I know my mother would have approved."

Lasting Treasures.

"Hess and Marian Haagen helped shape the character of our loving community, and that is perhaps their greatest legacy," says Vice President of Philanthropy and Community Engagement William Snyder. "They were smart, witty, delightful – and are very, very missed."

Married for 72 years, Hess and Marian Haagen, were residents of Luther Acres since 1995. Known and loved by everyone in the community, the couple has left a lasting legacy that will continue to touch – and enhance – the lives of Luther Acres residents for many years to come.

Hess and Marian are benefactors and founders of The Haagen Gallery. In dedicating the Gallery, Hess emphasized that Luther Acres made such an impact on his family, he and Marian wanted to give back in some memorable way. After he discovered that many residents shared their passion for art, the Gallery idea was born. The couple also introduced Luther Acres to the work of local artist Freiman Stoltzfus, who is the community's popular artist-in-residence today.

As Marian's health needs changed, she moved to the Healthcare Center. She loved spending time with Hess in the courtyard outside of her room. After she passed away in 2016, the courtyard became a beautiful sensory garden where residents can safely wander, explore and enjoy the vegetation. The garden contains three benches that Hess, their children and grandchildren dedicated to Marian's memory.

According to Spang Crest Rehab Nurse Leah Fies, family connections – both biological and emotional – are easy to find at Spang Crest.

Leah, whose mother is a long-time volunteer (and former rehab patient), and whose grandmother is proud to call the community home, says one of the best things about working at Spang Crest is that it truly is a family affair. "While I may have a family member who lives here, family ties at Spang Crest extend beyond traditional relationships," says Leah. "Here, residents quickly make friends who feel like family, and are cared for by staff members who treat them like family."

Leah started working at Spang Crest seven years ago, but her family connections to the community began long before. Leah's mother is a member of the Friends of Spang Crest auxiliary and is a gift shop volunteer. Her grandmother was also a long-time volunteer. "My Mom and grandmother used to come in together to make crafts for the residents and to decorate their room doors for a new season or holiday," says Leah. "They loved spending time with the residents and getting to know them."

Now as a resident, Leah's grandmother – who is approaching 95 – remains enthusiastic about life at Spang Crest. "She has settled into a nice daily routine," says Leah. "Exercise each morning at 9:05, afternoon activities in the Chapel with her friends and a daily visit from me! She's quite happy here. Her biological family is close by in Lebanon, and her new family is right here in Spang Crest."

Leah says health issues are preventing her mom from volunteering on a regular basis, but she tries to remain connected in other ways. "Mom LOVES the annual chicken barbecue, so she's working on selling tickets, and you can count on her to bring baked goods to the event."

Spang Crest Executive Director Daniel Deitzel says it's well-known throughout the area that Spang Crest embraces a family-focused philosophy. "Others may say they care for residents as though they were family," he says, "but at Spang Crest, it's true. You can see it and feel it as soon as you walk through our doors."

"Many employees have chosen to have their own family come here," adds Leah. "I think that's the best possible endorsement."

Love of Community Comes Full Circle

Ruth Ann Williams' parents were the second residents of the new St. John's Herr Estate back in 1991. Twenty-five years later, Ruth Ann and her husband, Chuck, chose the same path for the same reasons.

"Some things never change," says Ruth Ann. "We all want to feel secure in retirement. We want easy, worry-free lives. We want to know everything will be alright if our health needs change. Everybody wants to live a fulfilled and purposeful life surrounded by people who care. These are the reasons my parents chose to move here all those years ago. They're the reasons why we moved here, too."

Ruth Ann says she knew how happy life at St. John's could be after seeing her parents, Ruth and Richard Vogt, thrive in the community. "Even after my dad passed away, my mother stayed active and engaged. She had friends nearby, and when she moved to personal care, there was a kind, caring staff that took care of her every need."

Ruth Ann and Chuck have been married for 58 years and, for most of their married life, have lived in Columbia just a few blocks away from St. John's. "Another benefit of living here is that we can

stay in the community we absolutely love," says Ruth Ann. "Aside from the convenience of our beautiful cottage and the new friends we've made, nothing had to change for us. All the things we used to do, we still can, but now we have even more time to enjoy everything there is to offer both on and off campus."

The couple lives in a one-story cottage, which is a frequent stop on community tours. "We love showing our

cottage," says Chuck. "It's spacious and comfortable and has everything we need to lead an easy, carefree life. We like to say it offers the best bang for the buck!"

Just like her mother was, Ruth Ann and Chuck are active. They participate in countless activities, volunteer throughout the community, and sing in the holiday chorus. Chuck directs their church choir. What they say they most enjoy, however, is socializing with their neighbors. "We love the sense of community here," says Ruth Ann. "Once a month, several cottage

residents go out to lunch. Every Thursday, a smaller group of cottage residents also meet for lunch."

Chuck says he feels blessed to live at St. John's. "We moved here at the perfect time. Taking care of our home maintenance, etc. was becoming a challenge," he says. "We always tell people to 'Get on the list!' Why wait?"

Ruth Ann says her favorite thing about living at St. John's Herr Estate is that the lifestyle empowers them to maintain independence. "It's a wonderful situation. We're free and on our own, but also part of something bigger: a community."


